

Carefully cut out the walls (picture 1) and door posts (picture 2) of the roundhouse.





Stick the door posts to the other end of the wall (picture 3).

Flip the wall over. Make sure you know which edge is the top and get creative (picture 4).

Draw the items you might find inside an Iron Age house.

Did they have furniture? How did they cook? Did they have weapons? Did they keep animals?






Curl the wall around (picture 5) and stick the top and left door posts together (picture 6).





Carefully cut out the roof (picture 7). Flip it over and cut along the dashed line (picture 8).





Bring the cut edge up to the dark line and stick them together in a cone shape (picture 9).

Add a piece of sticky tape to keep everything together (picture 10).






Cut along the two short, dashed lines (picture 11) and fold this area back into the roof (picture 12).

This will be above the door.





Place the roof on the walls (picture 13).

Well done your house is complete.

It's still cold though. Cut out the fire and cut down the short dashed lines. Be careful not to cut all the way (picture 14). Slide the two parts together and arrange so the fire stands on its own. Place in the middle of your house and stay toasty.
