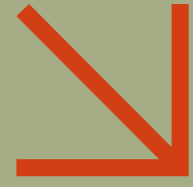

The evaluation aims to uncover and assess any archaeological features, structures, or finds within the targeted area, guiding decisions on preservation and further planning requirements.

Archaeological Excavation

An Archaeological Excavation, sometimes referred to as Strip, Map, Record, is an in-depth investigation of archaeological remains, often conducted as archaeological mitigation ahead of development. Excavations involve careful, controlled archaeological work in defined areas where significant archaeological deposits are known or expected. The aim is systematically examine, record, and preserve valuable archaeological information before it is removed.

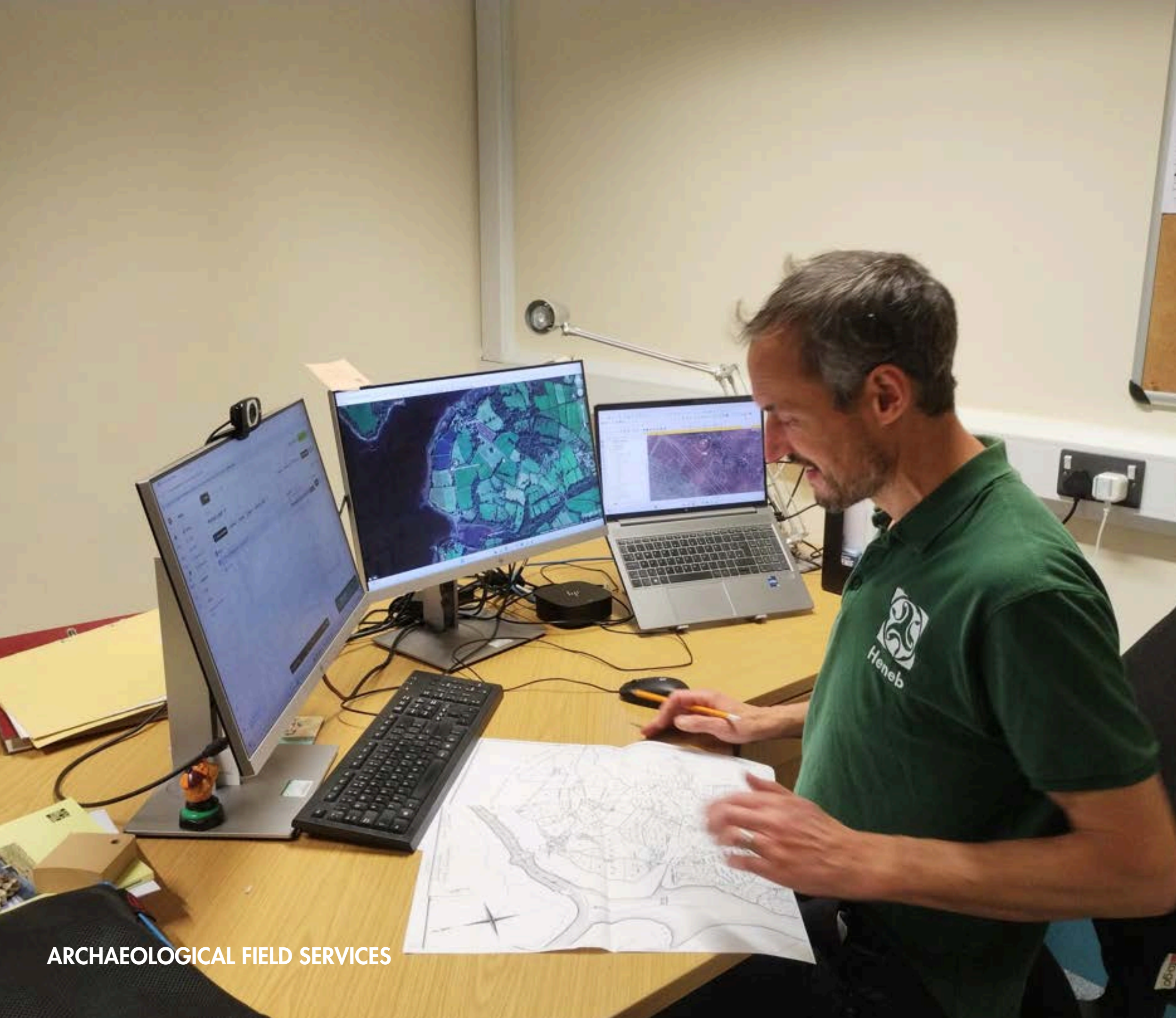
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Historic Building Recording
